



General Granbury's Outrageous Outhouse Race

Saturday March 18, 2017

Ladies and Gentleman....Man your Outhouses! Let's have fun and be SAFE!

Rules and Regulations

Structure:

1. Racer must resemble an outhouse. Creativity is encouraged. Please make it family friendly.
2. Outhouses are to have 4 walls, a roof, a doorway and a seat with at least one hole. It may also have a door, but the door *must* be secured Open during the race. Height not to exceed 8'
3. No glass may be used.
4. Outhouse must be human powered. No pedals, chains or engines. No mechanical assistance.
5. No outhouse will be designed or constructed with the intent to disable another outhouse.
6. This is a race, not a demolition derby. Act accordingly.

Teams:

1. A team shall consist of three people. One must ride inside. No team member can be replaced once the race has started.
2. A helmet is recommended for all of the team members. With or without a helmet, you assume the risk.
3. No rider under 15 years of age.
4. Clothing and shoes should be chosen for safety. It can be creative and outrageous, but not provocative.

Race:

1. Course will be one lap around the square. Races are by elimination, run in heats of four teams at a time.
2. During the race, the rider must be seated over the hole.
3. At the halfway mark the rider must switch positions with another team member.
4. Outhouse must be in upright position with the rider and at least one other team member pushing/braking as it crosses the finish line.

Prizes:

1. Traveling trophy shall be awarded to the First Place winner. Trophy shall be returned at the start of the next year's race. The winner's names will be etched on a plaque to be placed on the trophy. This can be the names of the individuals, team, organization, church, etc.

Schedule:

1. Outhouses and teams must be checked in by 2:00pm at the stage.
2. Preliminary races begin at 3:30pm.
3. The Outrageous Trophy will be presented at the finish of the Championship race.
