All prizes given by vendors must have prior approval by HGMA. (No live animals given as prizes)

2. Lessor reserves the right to change booth assignments at any time deemed necessary.

The undersigned hereby elects to and does release HGMA and its respective officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, rights or causes of action of whatsoever kind or nature which the undersigned has ever had or may now have or may hereafter have whether now known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, arising from or by reason of or any way connected with any injuries, losses damages, property damage or loss, or the results thereof, which heretofore has been or hereafter may be sustained by this undersigned as a result of or in connection with or arising out of the undersigned’s participation in the Memorial Day Crusin’ Granbury event.
